Dear Parent / Carer,

We are running a ski trip to Switzerland in the spring term next year from Saturday 19th January to Friday 25th January 2019.

All the boys who have taken part previously have found the week to be an invaluable experience not only in learning how to ski but also

- In developing social and communication skills
- Developing a sense of personal responsibility
- And learning how to look after each other.

Of course a major part of the experience is learning about different countries, cultures and environments. Clearly self-discipline, good manners and enthusiasm to test oneself are also developed.

We do appreciate that Year 11 will be preparing for summer exams. As a school, we will ensure the boys who are taking these exams will be provided with support, supervision and space, on a daily basis to continue their learning. An all-inclusive package includes return travel by air, resort transfers, full board accommodation, winter sports insurance, 5 day ski pass and 5 hours tuition per day, hire of boots, skis and safety helmet and all evening activities. The centre provides door step skiing with excellent snow guarantees. The cost of the trip is £785. I realise this is a lot of money, but I can assure families that it represents excellent value for money at a top resort in a very expensive part of the season. If families have financial difficulties please contact the school.

A deposit of £185.00 made payable to Norlington School will reserve a place but this MUST BE MADE BY THE END OF SEPTEMBER. Then further payments of £200 should be made by the end of October and November, leaving a final payment of £200.00 to be made by the 11th December. If you prefer the trip can be paid in full but must be paid by the 11th December. All payments must be made using ParentPay. The school does maintain the right not to allow a pupil to go on the trip if we consider their conduct or behaviour could compromise the health and safety of the rest of the party.

All boys who wish to go on the trip will need to hold their own passport and a European Health Insurance Card and will need to return the attached permission form signed by their parent / carer with the deposit. If students do not hold an EU passport they will need to ensure that they have all relevant documents for travel. **Please note that there will be no refunds once the trip has been finalised.**
