Norlington School and 6th Form Expansion Project

The Council would like to consult with you regarding planned construction work that supports a proposed expansion of Norlington School and 6th Form, Norlington Road for 150 students.

We plan to build the additional capacity by undertaking building works to the main school site. The Council has also purchased part of the Walbrook Works Estate, 66 Norlington Road and intends to develop this part of the site for school use as part of this planned expansion.

It is anticipated that works will comprise of:

- remodelling of existing school buildings.
- enclosure of two railway arches adjacent to the school playground to form curriculum spaces.
- remodelling of the large industrial unit adjacent to the school and demolition of part of the adjacent industrial units to form open space for the school.

The Council will be applying for planning permission to carry out the development on the sites and our colleagues in the Development Management team will write to local residents formally seeking comments and opinions.
