


Write a guidebook to multicultural Britain. It could include art, cuisine, fashion, sport. It must have information of the origins and heritage of those that influenced the modern day.


Create some Anglo-Saxon poetry based on scenes from daily life. The poems could be published in the Anglo-Saxon Chronicle.
