#### The Past, Present and Future of English Cricket Unite at Norlington School

Former Norlington School student and England Test captain **Graham Gooch** returned to his alma mater to officially open the school's brand-new **Cricket Academy**.



Gooch was joined by fellow Norlington alumnus Jamal Richards, 18, a rising star currently playing for Essex County Cricket Club and the England Under-19s. Together, they inspired a new generation of young cricketers from across North East London and the Essex Cricket Hub, who gathered to witness the launch of the academy.

The Norlington School Cricket Academy will offer state-of-the-art facilities, including a dedicated strength and conditioning suite, specialist cardio equipment, and both outdoor and indoor cricket nets. In partnership with Leyton Cricket Hub and with support from Essex Cricket, the programme will also benefit from specialist coaching staff.

Reflecting on the significance of the occasion, Graham Gooch said:

"I remember playing cricket in the playground next to where the new academy will stand. It's a great privilege, in the same week that England lifted the World Cup, to return to Norlington and open this new centre—one that will open countless doors for young cricketers in the area.

I've returned to this school many times since leaving in the 1960s and have been hugely impressed by how it has evolved. From a cricketing perspective, Norlington has always led the



way in developing young talent. This academy will help more students take that next step."

Jamal Richards, fresh from his international tour with England U19s, added:

"Norlington has an incredible record in school cricket. While I was here, we won everything. The passion for the game runs deep.

It's a real honour to support this new academy. It means those coming up behind me will have the same opportunities that I had.

I'm also grateful to the teachers who helped shape my journey—this is a chance to say thank you."
