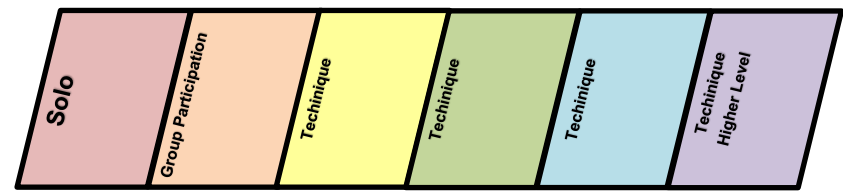

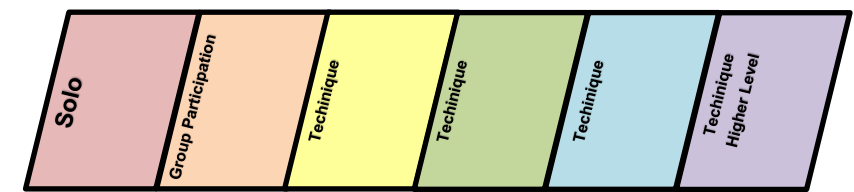
You will be given a stimulus in a group in order to rehearse and perform a group play using your understanding and practise of Stanislavski's techniques. (Naturalistic play).
