1. **Hegarty Maths** - <https://hegartymaths.com/>

Everybody in Year 8-11 has access to Hegarty Maths. Y7 will have access from 25th September.

Your teacher will set work for you to complete on Hegarty Maths on the same topics you would be completing in school.

How to log in to Hegarty Maths for the first time:

1. Go to <https://hegartymaths.com/>
2. Find our school by typing 'Norlington'
3. Enter your first name, last name and date of birth
4. Create a password
5. Congratulations, you are part of the Hegarty Maths family.

How to complete tasks on Hegarty Maths:

1. Go to 'My Tasks'
2. Find the tasks your teacher has set
3. Watch the associated video clip
4. Take notes of examples and important formulae
5. Complete the quiz
6. If you do not understand a question, leave a comment and your teacher will respond to help you
7. Request more work if you are finished
